Direction to Danish-Thai Chamber of Commerce Office

Danish-Thai Chamber of Commerce is located inside the village and a taxi or Grab is the most direct way to reach it. The office is at house number 59/193 Home place Village, Ramkhamhaeng Rd., Soi 140 Ratphattana, Saphan Sung, Bangkok 10240. As the office is inside a gated community, keep your ID card or Passport ready to exchange for a visitor's pass at the village entrance.

To reach the Danish-Thai Chamber of Commerce, enter Home Place Village via Ramkhamhaeng Soi 140. After passing the security gate, drive straight into the village until you reach the lake. Follow the road alongside the water all the way to the end of the lake, where you will find house number 59/193. The office is easily identified by the “Danish-Thai Chamber of Commerce” sign posted directly on the compound door.

Services provided by the Danish - Thai Chamber of Commerce

The chamber is a public non-profit organisation registered with the Ministry of Commerce and hold a unique position in Thailand compared with private service companies. Therefore, we strongly advise you to make use of the chamber services compared to less creditable organisations.

There will be cases where the Secretariat cannot directly assist but will then be able direct you to our more experienced members. Members using chamber services will also gain special member discount rates.

Most members of the chamber have been in Thailand for a long period of time and have thus gained considerable experience in establishing a company in Thailand as well running a company with several employees. Those members stand ready to help with advices for newly arrived Danish companies to overcome cultural and administrative challenges.

Year in Review 2023

19 January 2023- Multi-Chamber Networking at Baan Amata with STCC.

The Singapore-Thai Chamber of Commerce (STCC) along with Danish – Thai Chamber of Commerce (DTCC) and other foreign Chambers in Thailand, invited our members to a Multi Chamber Networking night at Baan Amata on Phetchaburi Road, Bangkok. This event gave DTCC members a chance to build your professional network, connect with new people, and explore business opportunities within the foreign business community in Thailand.



23 March 2023 - DTCC Annual General Meeting 2023.

On Thursday 23 March 2023 the Danish-Thai Chamber of Commerce held its AGM 2023 at Stable Lodge in Soi 8, Sukhumvit Road, Bangkok.

After welcoming 12 members and 7 proxies the meeting was deemed legal and within the requirements of the Department of Business Development regulations. Unfortunately, the NORDIC Embassies had chosen to hold NORDIC DAY at the Embassy of Norway on the same date and time making giving DTCC some competition for guests.

The Annual report from the board was presented as well as various news from the chamber office. The number of new fresh members has increased to 84 from 75 since the withdrawal of COVID restrictions.

Some of the key messages were:

The office has two employees: 1 full time Secretary/accountant and 1 part time (1½ days weekly) employed Executive Director (ED). From time-to-time student interns are engaged at the Chamber as well. Nevertheless, it was possible to arrange 20 events comprising social events, seminars, field visits, factory visits during

2022. In October 2022 an official Leif Ericson's Day was introduced as a networking business event celebrating the expansion of trade to the American continent being the first Europeans in North America.

Approved by the board, the Chamber Office took a number of management initiatives in 2021 and 2022, such as cutting working time, cutting staff, cutting bonus and relocation of the office. Furthermore, all IT work and programming has been done by the ED saving consultancy costs, which all in all has made a surplus of 309,000 THB for EOY 2022, the biggest for at least the past 10 years.



DTCC Events 2023

A proposal to lower the minimum board members from 7 to 5 was agreed on by majority voting. It was agreed to increase the minimum number of board members back to 7, whenever there are enough candidates competing for board seats.

Thus, it made it possible for the following 6 new board members to constitute a board:

At this truly Nordic event friends and members of the TNA enjoyed an evening with inspired warm and welcoming atmosphere. Even though, this event was mainly social it was possible to link up with new business connections and friends. This event was held at the Landmark Hotel on Sukhumvit Road.

25 May 2023 - Meet New Members, DTCC Business Networking Event.

It was a great pleasure for the chamber and its members to be entertained by the presentations given by B. L. Hua and M2 Animations at Stable Lodge Restaurant last Thursday 25 May 2023. Two very different business tales were unfolded that evening.

Director, Mr. Somsak Kungskulniti and the CEO, Mr. Tirapongse Pangsrivongse presented the company B. L. Hua Co. Ltd., a 100 years old pharmaceutical manufacturer, and distributor of pharmaceutical products and medical equipment/supplies from multinational companies from various parts of the world. It turned out that a major part of the pharmaceutical marketing comes from the Danish H. Lundbeck A/S (commonly known simply as Lundbeck) an international pharmaceutical company engaged in the research, development, manufacturing, marketing and sale of pharmaceuticals across the world.

Head of Studio, Owen Hurley, presented the company M2 Animation, which is headquartered in Aarhus, Denmark. However, the largest production studio is based in Bangkok, Thailand. Headquartered in Aarhus, Denmark, and with two state-of-the-art studios, one in Bangkok and the other in Mumbai, our 350+ family is a wealth of multicultural experience from North America, Europe, and Asia, with as many nationalities as we have disciplines.

12 June 2023 - DTCC Pandora Production Bangkok Factory Visit.



Thank you to Pandora Production for a great tour to one of the largest jewellery factories in the world. With 22 visitors signed up for the Monday afternoon factory visit the office had to close for registration a few days before the 12 June 2023.

CFO Christian Kruger gave us an interesting introduction to the Pandora adventure and evolution to become the world largest brand, since its start in 1982 where the company started as a family-run jewellery shop in Copenhagen. The company has two production sites in Thailand and markets its products in more than 100 countries on six continents with more than 6,700 points of sale. A third production facility is underway to be completed in North Thailand.



After the introduction and the Q&A the guests were split up into two groups: one Thai speaker and one English speaker and were guided around the many steps it takes to make the famous Pandora jewellery.

5 August 2023 - DTCC Visit to the 500 Years Old Trade Center in Ayutthaya.

On the 5 August 13 members followed the 500 years old tracks of the European and Asian traders that lightened up the Ayutthaya kingdom for more than 400 years as the biggest international business center of its time.

The trip started with a river cruise taking the guests along the river around the old UNESCO World Heritage site including few pier stops before the chamber boat landed at the 500 years old Portuguese Village where the history of the old church with all the remains (read skeletons) from the once flourishing 2000 persons village were situated.

Just on the opposite riverbank, the Japanese village boasted with live cool airconditioned trade museums and artifacts which were all explained by videos just as in the Danish National Museum. Thriving for a period of just 100 years until it was shut down by the Japanese Shogunate of fear from the western influence that came with trade goods.

however green it may have been, and Iceland was overexploited for natural resources, and trees and timber for boat building disappeared quickly. Only after the second world war reforestation was done seriously by the Iceland government.

Year in Review 2025

5 February: Information Meeting on Danish Regulations for Danes Living in Thailand

On 5 February 2025, Danes and their families gathered at the Embassy of Denmark to learn more about issues such as family reunification, Danish citizenship regulations for children born outside Denmark and the EU, the Danish national pension (Folkepension), regulations on double taxation, driving licence requirements, and other relevant topics.

Ambassador Danny Annan welcomed the many guests, together with Marianne Kruger (Representative for DW), and Michael Andersen (Secretary-General of DTCC). During the event, the partnership between the two organisations was once again confirmed.

At the meeting, Michael Bach Petersen, Secretary General of Danes Worldwide, accompanied by

Lisbeth Kjaergaard, Chief Legal Adviser at Danes Worldwide, gave a comprehensive presentation on the progress made in Denmark, particularly in cooperation with members of the Danish Parliament.

The legal aspects of family reunification, pensions, and the taxation of Danish income, presented by Lisbeth Kjaergaard, were especially informative. Michael Andersen also gave a short presentation on the Danish regulations concerning the use of a Thai driving licence while visiting Denmark.

Food, sweets, and drinks were partly sponsored by Pandora Production (Thailand), while coffee and tea were kindly supplied by the Embassy.

6 March: DTCC Business Networking Event – Income Taxation in Thailand & Abroad

It was a truly in-depth presentation delivered by Till Morstadt from Lorenz & Partners at the DTCC seminar on Personal and Corporate Income Taxation held at the Rembrandt Hotel Bangkok.

The following areas were covered: an overview of taxation in Thailand, corporate income taxation, and personal income taxation. The new tax regulations concerning overseas income were also addressed. It was noted that 2025 will be the first year in which cases are tested under the new taxation regime.

The issues presented by Till Morstadt were actively discussed by the participants, providing a valuable opportunity to explore the topics in greater depth through questions and dialogue. Participants also had the opportunity to share their own experiences with the lawyer and fellow attendees.

Following the seminar, the presentation slides and related information documents were shared with the participants. They were also briefed on how to obtain a tax certificate from the Danish tax authorities for use under the double taxation agreement between Denmark and Thailand.

On 8 April 2025, H.E. Ms. Suphanvasa Chotikajan Tang was granted an audience with His Majesty King Frederik X of Denmark and presented her Letters of Credence at Christiansborg Palace, thereby formally assuming her role as Ambassador with full diplomatic authority.

7 July: DTCC meet with the Falck Global Assistance Headquarter in Denmark

On 7 July 2025, DTCC met with the headquarters of Falck Global Assistance, represented by Maria Meng (CEO), Jose Luis Castellanos (Head of Global Network), and Sune Vibits (Country Manager), to discuss potential cooperation and to gain further insight into the structure and future outlook of Falck Global Assistance (FGA).

Falck was founded in Denmark in 1906 and is today present in 26 countries, employing more than 26,000 people globally. The Emergency Assistance Centre was particularly impressive, with more than 500 claims handlers and assistance coordinators managing approximately 250,000 cases annually.

Falck Global Assistance established its presence in Thailand in 2017 with the opening of a country office headed by Ms. Siriporn Wongrurai and staffed by 13 employees. The office primarily operates as a 24/7 assistance centre for customers experiencing medical emergencies or accidents within Southeast Asia, including Thailand, Malaysia, Indonesia, Singapore,

Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar, the Philippines, and Vietnam. Across these countries, Falck has built a network of 452 service providers, including hospitals and travel agencies.

In the future, the Thailand office may be expanded to include services for new local and international customers seeking to obtain insurance coverage with FGA.

The meeting also included a discussion on rising hospital costs in Thailand, particularly in relation to insured patients, which may contribute to increasing insurance premiums. Since 2009, Thailand has increasingly positioned itself as a medical hub for affluent patients from the Middle East, contributing to the commercialisation and growth of the private healthcare sector.

DTCC expresses its appreciation to FGA for the warm welcome and the informative tour of the impressive FGA Centre in Sydhavnen, Copenhagen.

Ambassador Gunnar Seidenfaden, the Father of the Embassy of Denmark in Thailand



Gunnar Seidenfaden (1908-2001) Diplomat and amateur botanist in his study and laboratory.

The Danish Embassy in Bangkok is located in the old Soi JUSMAG or Soi 1 Sathorn Tai Road close to Rama IV Road. If one comes from Rama IV Road, you may go down Soi Ngam Du Phli and pass by the old GI (US Soldiers) Hotel Malaysia. Another shortcut will bring you to the entrance of the old German Goethe Institute which among other holds a classic Swiss/German restaurant excellent for lunch meetings.

The Embassy of Denmark is being expanded to hold more employees and offices to accommodate the process of regionalization of the embassy and its staff. The work started in 2024 and is still ongoing and will most likely continue into 2027. While the embassy is still in its old shape it is felt as a good time to honor the person and the Seidenfaden family behind the embassy and it is a remarkable family indeed.

Former Ambassador Gunnar Seidenfaden (1908 – 2001) can in many respects be considered the ‘father’ of the Danish embassy both in forming the both landscape and the shape of the present-day embassy as the first Danish Ambassador in Thailand, from where he acted as ambassador to Manila (Philippines) from 1955, Rangoon (Burma) and Phnom Penh (Cambodia) in 1956 as well as to Vientiane (Laos) in 1957.

In 1954, Denmark appointed its first Ambassador to Thailand, Gunnar Seidenfaden, who effectively served in the period 1955-1959. Gunnar was a prominent botanist and a world class expert on orchids. Many of his live collections of orchids can still be seen at the Botanical Garden in Copenhagen and at Queen Sirikit Botanical Garden in Chiang Mai.

Gunnar Seidenfaden recommended that the Ministry for Foreign Affairs (MOFA) in Denmark acquired a large piece of land in Soi Attakarnprasit, also known as Sathorn Soi 1, from the Borneo Company. MOFA gave its permission 29 July 1955 to acquire the land with a limited budget of 1.2 million kroner.

The Seidenfaden Family. Gunnar was the nephew of **Major Erik Seidenfaden** (1881–1958), an amateur ethnologist and anthropologist who specialized in Thai ethnography after earlier culturally disappointing travels to the then Belgian Congo. Gunnar was the brother of the journalist and editor Erik Seidenfaden (1910-1990) who again was the father of Tøger Seidenfaden (1957-2011) former Chief Editor for Politiken.



A 22-year young Gunnar Seidenfaden together with his father Aage Seidenfaden before Gunnar had set out from Copenhagen with the Geographical Expedition towards East Greenland in 1900.

Gunnar's uncle, Erik Seidenfaden, arrived in Siam in 1906 to take up a position as an officer 25 years old in the provincial gendarmerie with the rank of major. Erik lived in Thailand until he returned to Denmark in 1946 after a remarkable career in Thailand where he wrote a number of guides and books on Thai culture and ethnography. Around 1900 the royal elite was trying to integrate its territories with a top led administration into a nation state by the formation of the gendarmerie with military police in almost all provinces of Thailand. Erik Seidenfaden was placed in Northeast Thailand during which he described the people living there as well as their geographical surroundings.

Erik was for a short period the president for the then newly established Siam Society and used the Society to publish great many papers on his observations as well as several guidebooks to cities and interesting places in Thailand. Many guidebooks were also written for the Royal State Railways of Siam during Eriks later employment for the railways.

The story of the Siam Society and the people who contributed to its publications is another story about expats in Siam/ Thailand and their own stories.

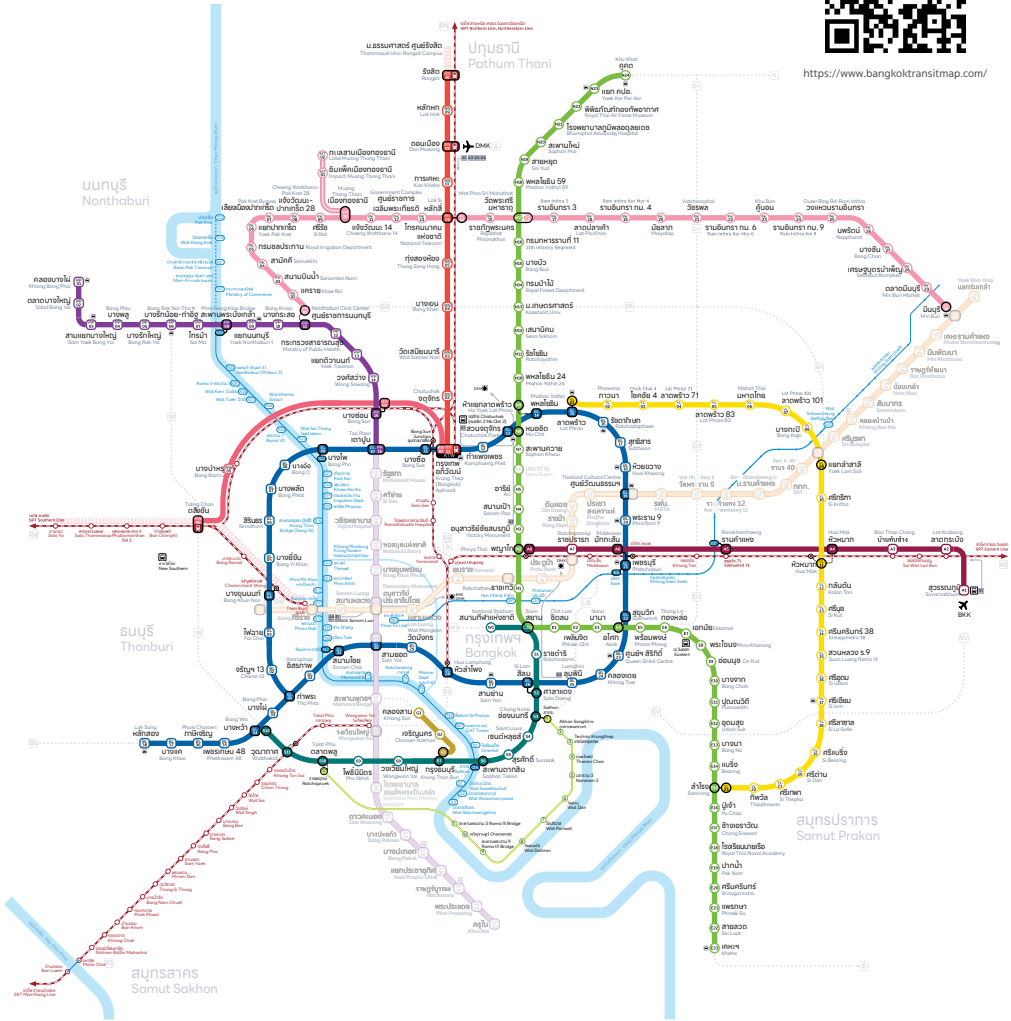
